Practised in Asia in different forms for centuries, Shiatsu became an independent modality in 1957, officially recognised by the <u>Japanese Ministry of Health, Labor, and Welfare</u>.

The ripple effect led to its increase in popularity and worldwide expansion.

Shiatsu combines ancient knowledge with modern techniques to enhance the body's natural ability to balance itself and achieve harmony. It works on all levels of being, including mental, physical, emotional



and spiritual. As such,
Shiatsu is a great tool for
holistic personal



As a minimum, Shiatsu students complete 1000 hours of training over the course of 3 years. Half of those hours are classed as guided learning hours and half are additional study hours.

Learning Shiatsu is a rigorous undertaking that goes beyond simple academic study, into the realm of holistic personal development.

There are many Shiatsu schools out there, offering qualification over different timeframes and with varying admission requirements. The **Shiatsu Society UK** acts as the over-arching professional body that protects and enhances high standards of Shiatsu practice by taking on the 'Internal Quality Assurance' and overall administration role.

By choosing a Shiatsu Society ratified school you don't just ensure the highest standards of education and practice; you can also work towards the LASER Learning Level 4 Diploma in Shiatsu, a certification equivalent to a foundation degree.



Awarded Diploma in Shiatsu

The Shiatsu Society partners with **LASER Learning Awards** to ensure the highest standards of education and practice of Shiatsu.



LASER Learning is an awarding organisation regulated by Ofqual, the regulator of qualifications, examinations and assessments in England.

The Laser Level 4 Diploma in Shiatsu provides the required knowledge and skills to be competent to provide Shiatsu to clients at a very high standard.

This qualification is suitable for those who wish to pursue a **career** offering Shiatsu as part of a complementary therapy business and for those looking to develop their **personal interest** in Shiatsu.

Graduates of the Level 4 Diploma in Shiatsu must complete a total training time of 1000 hours, of which 500 hours are guided learning hours, with the further 500 hours being additional learning hours. The qualification generally takes **3 years** to complete, but some schools offer part-time options. The curriculum includes five mandatory units:

- O Unit 1 Provide Shiatsu to Clients
- Unit 2 Shiatsu Core Theory
- Unit 3 Shiatsu: Lifestyle Medicine
- Unit 4 Shiatsu: Professional Development,
 Business Practice and Ethics
- Unit 5 Anatomy, Physiology and Pathology for Shiatsu

There are assessments for each unit and at the end of the course the qualified practitioner will be able to:



Explore and establish the client's needs for complementary and natural healthcare.



Develop and agree plans for complementary and natural healthcare with clients.



Provide Shiatsu to clients according to their individual needs and level.

All Shiatsu Society ratified schools are able to deliver the LASER Level 4 Diploma in Shiatsu.

Growth and holistic personal development are the focus of the Aberdeen School of Shiatsu. Run by three excellent teachers who have supported many students over the years, the school's origins go back to 1984 with the formation of the **Aberdeen East West Group**.

The Group thrived for many years, organising introductory courses in a wide range of subjects and leading the way in getting **complementary therapies** better known in the **Aberdeen** area. Regular Shiatsu classes were very popular and were the centre of its work; from this basis the full training was able to take off.

By 1992 the first full Shiatsu training course had started. The school trained many of the current practitioners in the North East of Scotland and Fife, and all the teachers of the school learnt with Laura.

Laura Davison, the Principal of Aberdeen School of Shiatsu, has been running Shiatsu training for 33 years.

The school aims to keep a strong focus on the practical aspect of the course, even when teaching anatomy, physiology and pathology.

As a small school, it is able to adapt to any special needs to help students achieve as much as they can. It offers a variety of options to practise or study Shiatsu, including:



LASER L4 Diploma in Shiatsu (Awarded): full 3-year professional training.



Grassroots Shiatsu: regular introductory and community classes or workshops.

01 LASER Level 4 Diploma in Shiatsu

The training is divided into 4 parts, starting with the **Living in Harmony Course** which focuses on the practical skills of Shiatsu. It introduces the theory of Shiatsu, the Shiatsu meridians and the Shiatsu points that help with common symptoms. For those wishing to continue their training in Shiatsu, the 1st year Living in Harmony Completion Course follows the Living in Harmony Course. This is followed by the 2nd and 3rd year of training and both of these include a 4-day residential. The training places emphasis on providing a greater sense of awareness and offers many ways to improve one's own personal health and wellbeing. This includes a tool-kit of complementary first aid points for use on family and friends, and a wide range of dietary and general recommendations for health and wellbeing.

The Northern School of Shiatsu

Set up in 1998 the Northern School of Shiatsu is committed to providing a person-centred, student-led approach to training, and focuses on the potential of Shiatsu in both the professional and self-development arenas.

The school offers a range of courses from 1-day tasters and a 3-weekend foundation course, through to the 3-year Diploma in Shiatsu, which is ratified by the Shiatsu Society. The school also offers a range of continuing professional development options for practitioners.

The Northern School's 1-year Holistic Acupressure Certificate is a professional qualification which enables students to offer relaxing treatments to the wider public within the limits of their knowledge and experience. The course is Zen Shiatsu based but includes the Chinese theory of the Five Elements as part of

the Acupressure Certificate.

Participants do not need any prior learning or experience to join the taster days or the foundation course (which can be taken as a standalone course or can form the first part of the 1-year Certificate).

The school has adopted a nonhierarchical, enabling approach to teaching and encourages students to recognise their unique style of learning and collaboration.

This fosters an atmosphere of openness and inclusion, encouraging students to find their own learning path within Shiatsu.

With small groups, supported by a teacher and an assistant, sessions aim to provide a safe, welcoming space where students can have a positive, fun learning experience and take away memories of their learning weekends long after the course is finished.

The Shiatsu College was established in 1986 to provide the best possible quality of Shiatsu training - it was among the very first of its kind.

The College now has five regional branches: Brighton, Hastings, London, Manchester and Norwich. Teachers at the different branches collaborate to develop best practice in teaching Shiatsu.

Their main approach is **Zen Shiatsu**; they also cover **5 Elements** and **Chinese Medicine**, and have a strong focus on developing physical practice and energetic awareness.

The College offers a supportive and inclusive atmosphere, and assessment is carried out through a combination of coursework, projects, and practical assessment.

All branches are ratified by the Shiatsu Society, and offer the full 3-year Shiatsu Diploma, and the 1-year Shiatsu College Bodywork for Wellbeing Certificate, as well as open classes and introductory workshops.

Brighton Branch

The Brighton branch of the Shiatsu College is based in Southwick, at the Sussex MS Centre, surrounded by parkland and just 10 minutes along the coast from the bustling centre of Brighton and Hove.

The school's focus is on creating a safe, kind, humour-filled and inclusive environment, to encourage learning through experience.

Each year the school welcomes the local community to join in on Saturday mornings to gain Shiatsu experience and knowledge - for use on self, family and friends to support relaxation and wellbeing.

The Saturday mornings run alongside the school's academic weekends and are accessible for people of any ability, bringing fresh Ki into the room to blend with that of fully enrolled students.

The school also invites former students and qualified practitioners to join in for full Saturdays. This is ideal for those needing support and keeping up to date with skills and knowledge. It is also ideal for connecting with fellow members of the Shiatsu 'family.'

Branch

Shiatsu College Manchester is run by an experienced team of teachers, led by Hannah Mackay (FwSS, BA, PhD). They love Shiatsu, and are enthusiastic about teaching students who want to work as professional practitioners, those learning Shiatsu for their own experience, or as an adjunct to an existing holistic practice.

Teaching is informed by the wide range of Shiatsu training and associated practices in which team members have participated, including Shiatsu with a wide range of teachers, acupuncture, Seiki, Movement Medicine and Qigong.

This branch of the Shiatsu College runs as a Community Interest Company, which means profits are invested back into the work. The school has recently set up a bursary fund to support students with fees. Located in central Manchester, the

school welcomes students from across the North of England, the Midlands, and North Wales. It attracts a vibrant and varied group of students, and a community of graduates and practitioners who pop in to participate in further training and help out.

Learning Shiatsu in Manchester is a fun and fulfilling experience, as well as being a high standard of training. Shiatsu is taught in an inclusive and supportive way, adapting to students' needs, for example around neurodiversity and disability.

Training happens one weekend per month, and all three year groups attend on the same weekend. This means students get to know a wider range of Shiatsu people, and the school can mix and match year groups as appropriate. Students also have input from different teachers over the course of the weekend.

The Shiatsu College London is one of five branches in the UK. All branches run the same modules over differing weekends; this continuity allows students to attend other branches if required, which is a great opportunity for students to catch up if they'd missed a weekend at their own branch. The school has committed and experienced teachers who can ensure that their students receive the best possible learning outcomes.

The school aims to equip students with the knowledge and confidence to become effective professional Shiatsu practitioners.

The Shiatsu College London has a diverse group of students currently in training, who benefit from a supportive teaching team and friendly administrators. Together they have a wealth of experience in Zen Shiatsu.

The branch is well situated and has excellent transport connections for the whole of the UK. Eurostar trains connect London to continental Europe, and the various London airports provide convenient connections further afield.

The London school allows prospective students to attend for a day or a weekend to gain a flavour of their teaching and of the Shiatsu diploma course. They have a nurturing and supportive teaching group who excel at sharing decades of Shiatsu experience. The school provides inclusive classes that take into account an individual's specific needs.

The London school doesn't have final exams, but continuously appraises student work via an online portal, with project work including, amongst others: Yin/Yang, the Five Phases, Reflective Practice, and Acupressure Points.

Glasgow School of Shiatsu

The Glasgow School of Shiatsu has been introducing people to Shiatsu and training practitioners since 1986.

The school offers the 3-year Diploma in Shiatsu (L4 on the UK RQF), a 1year Certificate in Acupressure for Health and Wellbeing, and a Certificate in Onsite Seated Shiatsu.

The focus is on student-centred training in a friendly and sometimes playful learning environment. Each level of the course is individual - no composite classes - meaning that classes are pitched to the exact stage of development of each group.

The school's 3-month foundation level course allows people to try Shiatsu before committing to a full year of study. Self-discovery and personal development are inherent in each level, using varying systems of East Asian medical philosophy.

The 1st year is based on the Theory of Five Elements; the 2nd year focuses on the versatile Zen Shiatsu system and includes a 4-day residential in the beautiful Trossachs region.

In the 3rd year, "Shiatsu Unlimited," the school encourages students "to develop your own style," with introductions to Seitai and specialist seminars on back pain and reproduction/pregnancy.

The school supports a thriving Shiatsu community in Glasgow with regular Practice Days open to current students, graduates, and practitioners.

The school has a low-cost student training clinic, and also runs CPD courses with national and international teachers.



Providing Shiatsu training in central London since 1988. The school's main teachers spent over five years each studying in Japan and hold the

highest teaching qualifications.

The school's purpose is to teach the style of Shiatsu studied by its main teachers in Japan at the lokai Centre and under Takeo Suzuki.

The College offers various classes and workshops, including a three-year Shiatsu practitioner course. This consists of weekly practical Shiatsu classes as well as theory classes in Western sciences and 'Oriental' medical theory. It also offers final year students the opportunity to enter a supervised student clinic.

The school's supervised Student Clinic is organised on a professional basis, with private rooms treating members of the public. It is an indispensable part of the practitioner diploma, replicating work in a professional environment, setting students up for their future career.

The London College of Shiatsu teaches and promotes meridian and zone therapy as a gentle yet effective therapeutic style of Shiatsu.

The School of Experiential Education

The centre for teaching Movement
Based Therapies and Somatic
Exploration. Based in Somerset, but
with a global presence, the school's
basic vision is that self-exploration
can be joyful and playful rather than
a serious process of 'getting better.'

The school runs postgraduate courses worldwide for body-based therapists. These courses train practitioners to involve the client more in the treatment, consequently teaching clients to be aware of their bodies and postural patterns and to experiment with changing those patterns.

The approach of Movement Shiatsu transforms Shiatsu from a treatment system to an education process. It focuses on waking up the developmental process using touch and activation of the archetypal movements associated with meridians.

This means that the client is helped to explore themselves and develop agency rather than being passively treated.

The school's courses are open to everyone, and they can be taken as journeys of self discovery or as a further, postgraduate qualification leading to a diploma.

The postgraduate programme covers:

 the Qi of specific meridians.
- Meridians and Development –
 Showing how infant movement development and psychosocial development are associated with the pathways of meridians and their Qi functions.

- Experiential Anatomy Showing how to teach clients to be aware of their body at a subtle level and how to listen to the needs and wisdom of each part.
- Working with Chronic
 Conditions and Special Needs –
 Movement Shiatsu is also an
 education system, teaching
 clients how to see their issues as
 opportunities for exploration and
 life learning.
- Inner Qigong and work with
 Breath and Voice Inner Qigong complements Movement Shiatsu.
 The movements and visualisations help people to be aware of how they embody each part of their energy system, and brings into consciousness those parts that need attention.

East West College

Based in Farnham (Surrey) the East West College specialises in short inperson courses for acupuncturists, and practitioners of Shiatsu and Chinese medicine.

East West College was founded in 2009 in Farnham to teach a three-year Diploma of Shiatsu. In 2012, with Fugaku Ito and Nicole Beauvois of Anma France, East West College organised two Diplomas of Anma at East West College, and workshops on Japanese Sotai techniques for releasing muscular tension.

Jamie Hamilton, the main tutor, graduated from the European Shiatsu School in Marlborough and became a 'Big T' teacher (MRSS (T)), and also studied the Six Divisions with Tim Mulvagh of Classically Based Shiatsu. Jamie has developed a new teaching on pulse diagnosis based on the Chinese classic 'The Mai Jing',

uncovering new aspects of diagnosis.

East West College is currently running programs and CPD courses, including a 12-day CPD training for acupuncturists in Exeter called:

- Diploma of Tuina and Advanced Bodywork. The Shiatsu part of the course has been very well received by acupuncturists, who have appreciated a more listening touch and yin way of treating.
